WELCOME BACK TO MUSIC 2021

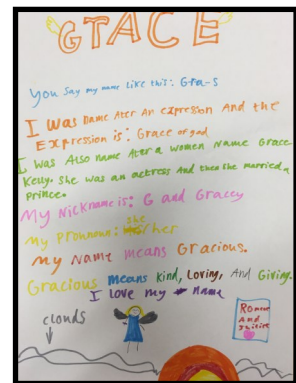
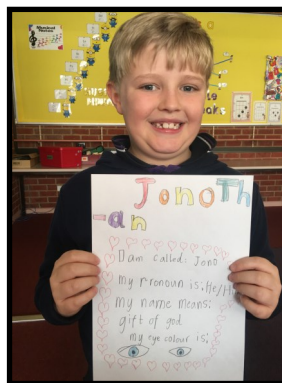
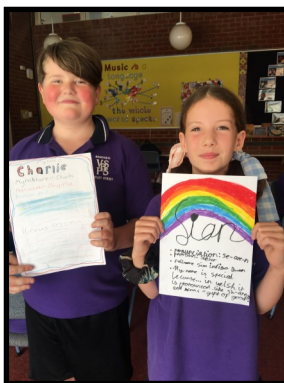
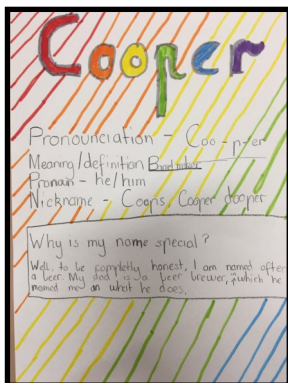
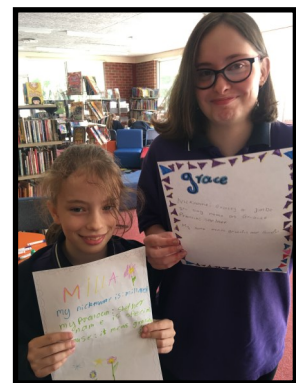
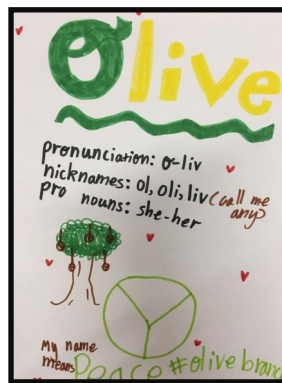
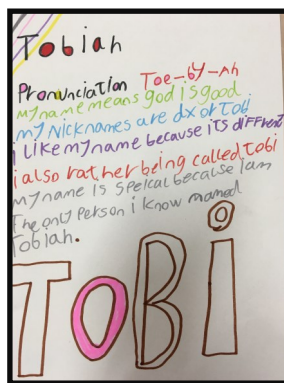
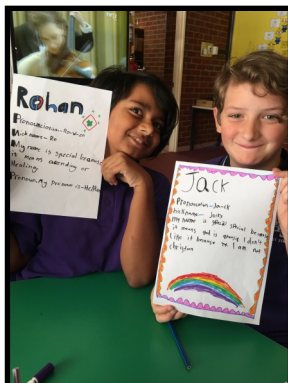
It's very exciting to be back in the Music room for 2021! I was happy to see so many familiar faces and meet the new Foundation students and along with some new children in other grades.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am an experienced piano teacher living in Castlemaine. My background also includes fourteen years working as a qualified teacher in primary schools, mostly in NSW.

Piano lessons are:

- * provided by myself on a private basis, with one-to-one tuition,
- * provided during school hours, but fees are payable directly to myself, and enrolments made with me,
- * rotated to a different time each week, so that students don't miss the same classroom lesson each week,
- * 30 minutes duration at a cost of \$27.00 for each lesson,
- * payable in advance for a full term (or two equal instalments payable at the beginning of the term, and midway through the term).

It is also necessary to purchase a Piano Lesson Book for students having lessons. I will lend a book to students for the first couple of weeks.

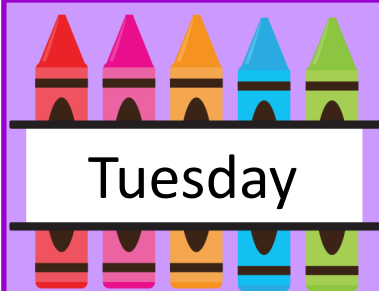
Please contact me directly if you have any queries.

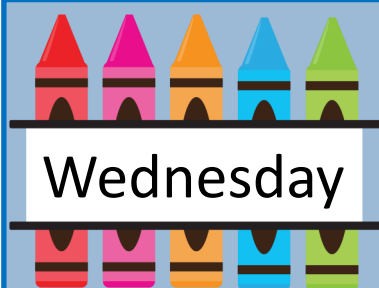
