The Power of Play

Investigation Time is an authentic, hands-on approach that engages and stimulates learning in children. It better meets the needs of individual children in the most natural way and provides the opportunity to practice essential skills.

- Involves Literacy and Numeracy.
- Promotes social skills: taking turns, persistence, resilience, getting along, organisation and confidence.
- Develops speaking and listening skills: provides authentic opportunities for children to communicate and interact with each other.
- Provides open-ended, hands on experiences which fosters creativity, thinking skills, problem solving, imagination, responsibility, questioning, reflecting.
- Develops gross and fine motor skills.
- Engages and supports creative learning opportunities.
